

2019 OFFICIAL’S ADVISORY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

- N 1. Recommend – Send a survey to Head Coaches and Officials asking if they think there is a need in attending an In-Person Rules Meeting every other year
Rationale:
 1 – In-Person Rules Meetings are more informative and allow for Q and A.
 2 - Connection between Officials and Coaches is getting lost
Motion Passed: 6-0
Staff reasoning – Only Head coaches? All coaches? If all coaches, where would all of the officials and coaches meet? What are repercussions for not attending? Coaches don’t want to miss practice time, Officials rules meeting items are different than coaches meeting items.
- Y as Amended 2. Recommend – Once an Official reaches 25 years of service (not sport specific), they should choose which sport State Championship they would like to be recognized.
NOTE: In order to be recognized, they must have been registered in that sport for a minimum of 5 years.
Rationale:
 1 - NFHS 25 Years of Service award is NOT sport specific.
 2 –Currently, only recognize an official who has reached 25 years in a specific sport
 3 – Currently, we recognize them for the first sport they meet the 25 year requirement
Motion Passed: 6-0
