

Summary of the Soccer Advisory Committee Meeting with Board Action

November 28, 2023

1. Recommend: The actions defined as dissent under the criteria for the yellow cards for unsporting dissent should be clearly articulated and defined and placed as a point of emphasis in the Online Rules Review. Furthermore, the actions resulting in a yellow card for unsporting dissent rule should be articulated in the pregame meetings.

2. Recommend: A study related to the effectiveness of the yellow card for unsporting dissent actions should be conducted next year during the soccer advisory committee meeting.

* **3. Recommend:** An item be placed on the annual ballot to amend By-Law 3.13.2.a to read "A student shall neither practice nor compete as a member of a non-school team or as an individual participant in organized non-school competition in that same sport, except as provided for specifically below. ~~In order to be eligible for the school team, the student must join the team at the start of the season and attend all scheduled school practices and contests.~~ An athlete choosing to be involved in a HS sport must join the HS team prior to the first full week of allowable games. Participation in a non-school sport event that is specifically allowed in Section 3 must be approved in advance by a school administrator. Absences not related to non-school competition will be handled locally."
