Summary of the Soccer Advisory Committee Meeting with Board Action

November 28, 2023

1. Recommend: The actions defined as dissent under the criteria for the yellow cards for unsporting dissent should be clearly articulated and defined and placed as a point of emphasis in the Online Rules Review. Furthermore, the actions resulting in a yellow card for unsporting dissent rule should be articulated in the pregame meetings.

2. Recommend: A study related to the effectiveness of the yellow card for unsporting dissent actions should be conducted next year during the soccer advisory committee meeting.

* **3. Recommend:** An item be placed on the annual ballot to amend By-Law 3.13.2.a to read "A student shall neither practice nor compete as a member of a non-school team or as an individual participant in organized non-school competition in that same sport, except as provided for specifically below. In order to be eligible for the school team, the student must join the team at the start of the season and attend all scheduled school practices and contests. An athlete choosing to be involved in a HS sport must join the HS team prior to the first full week of allowable games. Participation in a non-school sport event that is specifically allowed in Section 3 must be approved in advance by a school administrator. Absences not related to non-school competition will be handled locally."
