## Swimming and Diving Advisory Committee Summary Held March 3, 2021

- Recommended the elimination of automatic qualifying standards for swimming and diving, in favor of only utilizing the consideration standards to determine the 32 qualifiers in all **swimming** events (diving-see item #3).
- 2. Recommended (as per number 1 above) the Board's approval of the applicable updates to the Swimming (only) State Qualification procedures used to determine the state qualifiers for both classes (specifies the use of consideration standards only, with the applicable data points for review annually), and recommended NO CHANGES to the current consideration qualifying standards for both Class 1 and Class 2.
- 3. Recommended the adoption of a District Diving qualification system for state to begin in 2021-22, in order to eliminate the effect of inconsistent and sometimes inflated scoring at some meets throughout the season that have possibly allowed inappropriate state qualification. The total number of diving qualifiers for state will remain at 32.
- 4. Recommended that for regular season meets which split the swimming and diving portions on separate days, the two portions must both take place within a 7-day period, with the same schools involved.
