## 2023 Wrestling Advisory Committee March 6, 2023

- Recommend to hold the State Wrestling Championships (Boys & Girls) on Week 34 of the MSHSAA Standardized Calendar and to leave the 1<sup>st</sup> Allowable Practice Date at Week 18 (Girls) and Week 19 (Boys) of the MSHSAA Standardized Calendar.
- 2. Recommend to continue with using the 2 two-day state tournaments format (3 Classes per tournament).
- 3. Recommend keeping the state tournament schedule by Class the same as used in 2023 (do not rotate schedule by Class).
- 4. Recommend to leave the Boys and Girls State Wrestling Championships together at the same site during the same week until number of registered schools deems necessary to add a 3<sup>rd</sup> Classification of Girls Wrestling or other variables cause a need for change.
  - 5. Recommend to add the following note being added to district "Seeding Criteria" in the MSHSAA Manual: Note "Returning" is defined as a wrestler who meets any of the applicable criteria from any previous season (not just the prior season).
  - 6. Recommend a change to Section 4 Item 4-C in the Wresting Manual as follows: C. Any coach may submit the name of a <u>maximum of one</u> wrestler for consideration to be seeded <u>per seed in each weight class</u>, regardless of whether or not the wrestler is a member of his <u>or her</u> team.
  - 7. Recommend to allow edits to Seeding Guidelines in Section 4 and Appendix D to ensure that language regarding Seeding Guidelines is consistent and the same.
  - 8. Recommend starting Girls Wrestling weigh-ins on Friday of districts at 4pm.
  - 9. Recommend editing the District tournament suggested schedule to reflect the Quarterfinals and 1<sup>st</sup> Round Wrestleback administered in the same round.
  - \*\*\* 10. Recommend surveying head wrestling coaches to measure their level of support for considering a 7<sup>th</sup> place match (7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> place medals) at the State Wrestling Championships. Results of survey to be considered by board of directors as well as a comparison of the percentage of medalists vs. number of qualifiers, number participants that can enter postseason and number of overall participants in other sports.
